Could someone please read "The Tradition of the Month"?

Could someone please read "The Abstinence Statement"?

This meeting is also a chip meeting as we would like to take this time to offer a welcome or surrender chip to anyone present and to acknowledge those who have achieved a length of sobriety from their Inner Circle behaviors for 30, 60, or 90 days, six months, nine months, one year or multiple years. The meeting is now turned over to our Chip Meister \_\_\_\_\_.

This meeting is for discussion and sharing of your current work in the SAA program. When sharing, we caution you not to divulge any illegal behavior such as deliberately exposing someone to HIV, child molestation, sex with a minor, sex in public, and any other sex crimes, as such information could be used against you in a court of law. If you feel someone is being too explicit in their shares, please do not hesitate to raise your hand. Shares may be timed based on group attendance. The meeting is now open for sharing.

(at 6:50pm) That is all the time we have for sharing. If you did not get an opportunity to share or felt uncomfortable sharing, please grab someone after the meeting. I would like to take this opportunity to say to everyone, especially the newcomers, to Keep Coming Back.
